## **REVISED SCHEDULING ORDER**

THIS MATTER is before the Court on the Parties' Joint Motion to Amend Certain Scheduling Order Deadlines. (ECF No. 60.) Upon receiving the Parties' Joint Motion, and finding it appropriate to do so, the Court convened a scheduling conference, on the record, via telephone on October 26, 2018. At this conference, the duly appointed representatives of both sides confirmed that discovery in this matter will conclude no later than February 12, 2019 and further agreed to the briefing schedule that follows.

Accordingly, the following is HEREBY ORDERED:

- Motions for Summary Judgment are due on March 1, 2019. Responses are due on March 15, 2019, and replies are due on March 22, 2019.
- The Court will conduct a Summary Judgment Hearing on April 8, 2019 at 10:00 a.m.

- Motions challenging expert witness designations are due by April 15, 2019. Any responses shall be filed within seven (7) days, and replies are due three (3) days thereafter.
- Non-dispositive motions are due by April 26, 2019. Any responses shall be filed within seven (7) days, and replies are due three (3) days thereafter.
- The Parties shall submit a Proposed Final Pretrial Order along with their final witness and exhibit lists on May 9, 2019.
- A Final Pretrial Conference is scheduled for May 10, 2019 at 10:00 a.m.
- The Parties' objections to any fact witnesses, exhibits, or designated discovery shall be made in writing and are due by May 13, 2019.

A bench trial is scheduled for May 20, 2019 through May 31, 2019, with court beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day of trial. No motions in limine will be heard on the day of trial. The Parties' proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law are due within ten (10) days of the conclusion of trial.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the Court's Scheduling Order, dated October 22, 2018 (ECF No. 59) is HEREBY VACATED, and the Parties' Joint Motion to Amend Certain Scheduling Order Deadlines (ECF No. 60) is DENIED AS MOOT. Finally, to the extent that this Order is inconsistent with the Court's previous Scheduling Order (ECF No. 27) and the Initial Pretrial Order (ECF No. 46), the contents of this Order shall be controlling.

The Clerk is DIRECTED to send a copy of this Order to all counsel of record.
