

REFORM REQUIRES TRANSPARENCY

2016-2019 FAIRFAX COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT DISPARITY IN ARRESTS After Adoption of Ad Hoc Police Practices Commission Recommendations

We and other advocates have been asking for demographic breakouts of data for not only use of force, but other key police actions, such as arrests (by category), misdemeanors (summons and custodial arrests), stops and traffic citations. To date, the data has not been published. Set forth below is data ACLU People Power Fairfax has received under FOIA for 2016—2019 for arrests by category of crime, disaggregated by race and ethnicity. We have analyzed it to determine the level of disparity for people of color. See Appendix for further information about data and calculations.

The disparity in arrest rates for Blacks has increased each year since 2016, from 2.5 to 4 times their representation in the overall population. Hispanics are also disproportionately arrested, at a rate about 2 times that of their population. There is wide variation in the extent of disparity between different crimes. With the exception of pornography, however, Whites are under-represented in every individual category of crime.

APPENDIX

Legends:

- 1. **IBR:** Incident-Based Reporting in accordance with national uniform standards. Arrest numbers are calculated based on information in the Records Management System on the date the report was generated. Runaway is non-criminal but tracked. Data shown is based on number of charges, not number of persons arrested.
- 2. **Disproportionality (D)**: Proportion of arrests charges for members of a demographic subgroup relative to the percentage of the same subgroup in the population. When D = 1 means that % of charges equals % of the population for the group. A number below 1 means that % of charges is fewer than the % of the population for the group. Alternatively, a number above 1 indicates that % of charges exceed % of the population for that group. For instance, in 2019, the overall D for Blacks was 4.0; this means that the percentage of Blacks with arrests charges was 4 times higher than the percentage of Blacks in Fairfax County population. To simplify, we can look at D as a risk factor. The risk for Blacks Fairfax residents to have an arrest charge is more than 4 times that of a White resident, considering their representation in the overall Fairfax population.
- 3. Other races: Includes Native Americans, Asians, Native Hawaiians or other Pacific islander, some other race, and two or more races; not Hispanics.

- 2016 to 2018 Data Source: 17-FOIA-404v5 prepared by FCPD dated 9/18/2017 received by ACLU People Power Fairfax. Numbers are for charges, not arrestees.
- **2019 Data Source**: 20-FOIA-497 prepared by FCPD dated 6/22/2020 received by ACLU People Power Fairfax. As above, numbers are for charges, not arrestees.
