

PREPARE FOR ICE RAIDS

Designate a Standby Guardian who can care for and make decisions for your children in your absence. **Memorize** and carry your lawyer's number with you. **Make a plan** and give it to trusted friends or family with your:

- ★ Personal details: *name, SSN/ITIN, A-number, place of birth*
- ★ Contact info: *emergency contacts, lawyer, embassy or consulate*
- ★ Family details: *children's caregivers, doctors, medication info, allergies/dietary needs*



WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE STOPPED BY ICE

If you're not a U.S. citizen, you should:

- ★ Stay silent & calm.
- ★ Don't open the door or let them inside.
- ★ Ask them to show you a warrant.
- ★ Say "no" when asked to search.
- ★ You don't have to give them your ID, work authorization, or ANY papers.
- ★ Never show false documents or lie about being a citizen.

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

WHEN INTERACTING WITH ICE IN THE DMV

WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE ARRESTED BY ICE

- ★ Stay silent & calm.
- ★ Do not discuss your immigration status or sign anything.
- ★ Say you need an interpreter.
- ★ You have the right to a lawyer even if you cannot pay.
- ★ You have the right to a phone call, but it will be monitored unless you're speaking to a lawyer.



An ICE warrant (Form 1-200) does NOT give ICE permission to enter your home. A criminal warrant signed by a judge MAY give ICE permission to enter.

You **DO NOT** have to answer questions about:

- ★ Your immigration status.
- ★ Where you were born.
- ★ How you entered the country.
