NOTICE AND MOTION FOR NONSUIT

Pursuant to Va. Code Ann. § 8.01-380, Petitioners hereby move this Court for a voluntary nonsuit against all Respondents and that such nonsuit be granted without prejudice. In support thereof, Petitioners state the following: On April 22, 2020 Petitioners filed a Petition for a Writ of Mandamus against Respondents the Commonwealth of Virginia, Ralph Northam, Brian Moran, Harold Clarke, Valerie Boykin, Adrianne Bennett, and all Circuit and District Courts. Pursuant to a settlement agreement reached in an unrelated case, on May 19, 2020, Petitioners filed a Motion for Leave to Amend the Petition for Writ of Mandamus to dismiss State Respondents from the action, leaving as Respondents all Circuit and District Courts. Respondents have not filed any counterclaims or crossclaims, and Petitioners have taken no previous nonsuits in this case.

Therefore, Petitioners respectfully request that the Court grant the requested nonsuit.
