[PROPOSED] ORDER OF DISMISSAL

For good cause shown, and in consideration of the Parties' Joint Motion to Dismiss and Retain Jurisdiction ("Joint Motion"), the Court hereby GRANTS the Joint Motion.

The Court hereby conditionally dismisses the above-titled action with prejudice under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(2) and specifically retains jurisdiction for the purpose of interpreting and enforcing the Settlement Agreement, which was filed with this Court as Exhibit A, in accordance with its terms only with respect to any disputes arising thereunder regarding Defendants' enforcement of E.O. 2 or S.B. 739 against Plaintiffs' schools or school divisions with regard to peer masking as a reasonable modification for the individual Plaintiffs in their schools.

The Clerk shall close the case.
