SUPPLEMENTAL AFFIDAVIT

State of Virginia, City of Richmond, to-wit:

DONNA M. SHIFLETT, first being duly sworn, states as follows:

1. I am the Manager of Court and Legal Services (“Court & Legal”) for the Virginia Department of Corrections (“VDOC”). Court & Legal is responsible for computing an inmate’s sentence(s) and projecting his discretionary parole eligibility date, mandatory parole release date, and good time release date.


2. I base the information contained in this affidavit on personal knowledge and records maintained in the regular and ordinary course of business. This affidavit supplements the information provided in my previous affidavit, executed November 6, 2023.

3. I understand that Leslie L. Puryear (“Puryear”), VDOC No. 1387533, filed a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus generally alleging that he had been wrongfully determined to be ineligible to accrue earned sentence credit at the higher rate set forth in subsection (B) of Code § 53.1-202.3, which went into effect July 1, 2022.


4. On November 9, 2023, having fully satisfied his active term of incarceration, VDOC released Puryear to the Petersburg Probation and Parole District. Accordingly, Puryear is no longer in VDOC custody.

5. To the best of my knowledge and information, Puryear has received all appropriate sentence credits, and his sentence has been accurately calculated in accordance with applicable Virginia statutes and time computation practices.
